Federations should register the riders with their National plate number. In the case of conflicting platenumbers in a category the UEC platenumber will be used, otherwise a number will be provided by the Dutch organisation.

Federations have to pay for registrations by bank transfer to the bank account of the organiser.

Every rider will become a bracelet to indicate they are registered for the race. Riders can be registered at the race but they will have to pay double amount.

PRIZES AND AWARDS

- For Challenge classes Boys and Girls 8- till 15/16: trophies for 8 finalists of each category per race.
- For Challenge classes Cruisers / Men 17+ / Women 17+: trophies for 3 finalists of each category per race.
- Boys and Girls 15/16 will also have a competition over 3 races. The best 3 overall riders in the category Boys 15/16 will win a GT-bike. The overall winner of the category Girls 15/16 will also win a GT-bike. The 2 best overall riders in the category Boys/Girls 15/16 will win a BMX AIR travel bag for 20" bikes.

3-Nations Trophy

At the race in Zolder a 3-Nations Trophy will be presented to the country with the best result over the 3 races.

- Riders in the following categories will earn points for their country:
boys/girls 7/8, 9/10, 11/12, 13/14, 15/16, Junior men, Junior Women, Elite Men, Elite Women.
- The winner of each category earns 10 points, then 8, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1.
- In the case of 2 countries having an equal amount of points at the race in Zolder, the country with the best result at the last race will be decisive as to which country wins the 3-Nations BMX Cup.

CAMPING

The camping area is situated close to the track and offers all facilities: hot/cold water, electricity, showers, toilets etc. In Germany the organizer will only have about 60 places with electricity, because of an exhibition. Some places without electricity are available too.

Prize of a camping place for the weekend: € 35,00. Signs will lead you from the entrance of the village.
