DEAR GUESTS, WELCOME TO AHNATAL!

We are very proud and excited, to welcome all athletes, teams, officials and spectators to our first international Race in Ahnatal, in the middle of Germany!

BMX-Racing is very new for our Club and our region.
2012 was the opening ceremony and the first race on our track.

The track is one of the best tracks in Germany and Europe! It was built and designed by Tom Ritzenthaler in the years 2010 and 2011. We have a 5m UCI-Standard starting-hill and a split 2nd-straight. The track is really fast, about 32s for a top lap!

The municipality of Ahnatal was created within the framework of municipal reform in Hessen on 1st August 1972 by the merger of the villages of Weimar and Heckershausen. Since that time experienced a steady upswing Ahnatal is today an interesting and popular, through a variety of clubs, associations and public institutions distinct residential community in the direct surroundings of the city of Kassel, at the edge of the nature park Hawk forest between Dörnberg and Stahlberg. Ahnatal far has a millennial history. You can even assume that people here have already lived in the 4th century before Christ's birth. Finds from this period are testimony.

Come to Kassel, the "Capital of the German Fairy Tale Route" where art and nature are equally important. Magnificent parks, internationally renowned art treasures, historical monuments and cultural institutions draw millions of visitors every year to this attractive city at the River Fulda. Kassel, situated in the heart of Germany, is easily and quickly accessible by Interrail or on the motorway. We look forward to seeing you here in Kassel.

Relaxation, nature enjoyment & spa in Bad Wilhelmshöhe

The mountain park Wilhelmshöhe is unique in the world. More than 400 woody plant species and beautiful plants grow on 240 hectares. When leisurely strolling or hiking, you will discover highlights, such as the nearly 300 years old Herkules, the fabulous Löwenburg, the Ballhaus, the greenhouse or just listen to sweet music during the mountain park concerts in the band stand. The highlights are the water-works in the summer months, always from the 1st of May to the 3rd of October, on Wednesdays, Sundays and public holidays, starting from 2.30 p.m. – This is an experience you do not want to miss! Very popular: the thermal spa 'Kurhessen Therme' with its large sauna area at the foot of the mountain park.

Arts, culture & architecture

Even the electors and landgraves of Hessen-Kassel were very interested in culture and all too happy to indulge their pronounced passion for collecting. As a result, Europe's oldest public museum and

Germany's first established theatre building were constructed: the Fridericianum and the Ottoneum. Marvel at the precious collections, such as the Alte Meister gallery, with works by Rembrandt, Rubens and Dürer. Or visit the Caricatura- Germany's unique forum for comedy and satire – or the unique Museum für Sepulkralkultur. With the world exhibition "documenta", which takes place every five years, Kassel has become the navel of the world in regards to contemporary art.

At the race in Zolder a 3-Nations Trophy will be presented to the country with the best result over the 3 races.

Riders in the following categories will earn points for their country:
boys/girls 7/8, 9/10, 11/12, 13/14, 15/16, Junior men, Junior Women, Elite Men, Elite Women.

The winner of each category earns 10 points, then 8, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1.

In the case of 2 countries having an equal amount of points at the race in Zolder, the country with the best result at the last race will be decisive as to which country wins the 3-Nations BMX Cup.

A little Camping site is near the track, named "Campingplatz Bühl". With a car you can be in 6min. at the track, with a bike it's about 15min.

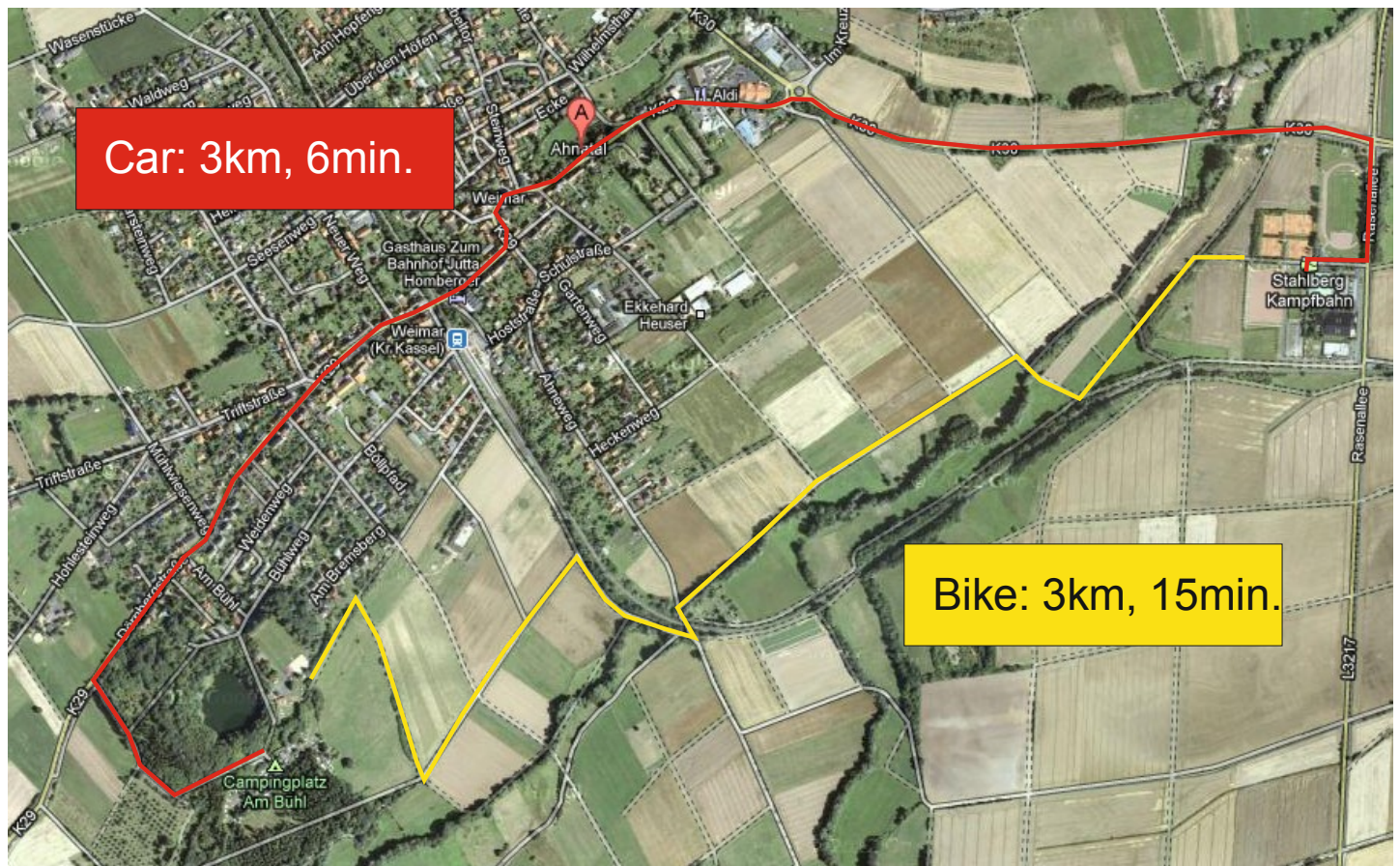
